## ORDER TO APPEAR AT CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE AND ORDER DIRECTING PARTIES TO PREPARE CASE MANAGEMENT REPORT

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on case management review pursuant to Rule 2.545, Fla. R. Jud. Admin., Rule 1.200, and Administrative Order 3.107 & 3.108. If there are outstanding motion(s) that are not set for hearing, the Court directs the parties to set the outstanding motion(s) for hearing at UMC to be heard within 30 days from the date of this order.

#### **Mandatory Case Management Hearing**

The Case Management Hearing is scheduled for August 19, 2021 at 1:30 p.m., in courtroom 9C at the Palm Beach County Main Courthouse, 205 North Dixie Highway, West Palm Beach, FL 33401. The purpose of this Case Management Hearing is to discuss the status of the case, resolve outstanding issues, determine what action is necessary to get the case at issue and proceed towards case resolution.

Parties must bring their calendars to the Case Management Conference to schedule matters as deemed necessary by the Presiding Judge. At the Hearing the Court may:

- 1. Conduct a hearing on all motions pending as of the date of this Order;
- 2. Assign the case to a case track
- 3. Schedule or reschedule the service of motions, pleadings and other papers;
- 4. Limit, schedule, order or expedite discovery;
- 5. Discuss any other issue that may advance the resolution of the case;
- 6. Pursue the possibilities of settlement;
- 7. Schedule other Hearings or determine other matters that may aid in the disposition of the action; and/or
- 8. Set or reset the time of trials

#### **Mandatory Case Management Report**

A Case Management Report and proposed deadlines shall be filed by each party with the Clerk of Court and served on opposing parties, with a courtesy copy emailed to the presiding judge at the divisional address. This report shall be filed and delivered no later than ten (10) days prior to the scheduled Case Management Hearing Date.

NO schedule proposed may exceed Florida Rule of Judicial Administration Time Standards, which provides 12 months for non-jury trials and 18 months for jury trials from the date of filing unless this action qualifies as a complex case under Rule 1.201, Fla. R. Civ. P. and the Court has granted the motion to deem the case complex prior to this submission.

The Case Management Report must include:

- 1. A brief summary of facts and theory of liability and/or defenses;
- 2. Pleading status and a proposed deadline for amendment of pleadings;
- 3. Status of outstanding discovery and proposed schedule and deadlines:
- 4. Status of exchange of discovery including interrogatories, requests to produce, document subpoenas, and requests to admit, including any objections to same or claim of privilege and a deadline for all such discovery;
- 5. Fact discovery including a schedule of fact witness depositions by name and date; and
- 6. Expert disclosure and discovery, including a schedule of expert witness depositions by name and date;
- 7. Dispositive motions anticipated and a deadline and briefing schedule for such motions;
- 8. Mediation efforts and a deadline for mediation and the name of mediator selected; and
- 9. A statement as to anticipated date for trial readiness. This date must be identified as a date by which the parties will be ready for trial and must specify whether the trial requested was jury or bench.

Parties may opt out of attending the case management conference by submitting an Agreed Case Management Plan and Order Approving Agreed Case Management Plan for the Court's approval and signature 10 days prior to the hearing. The proposed Order Accepting Agreed Case Management Plan should also include language with the date and time of the hearing to cancel the Case Management Conference.

The Court prefers a joint submission, however, if counsel will not cooperate, a unilateral submission will be accepted subject to attached proof of attempts to meet and confer to resolve the report.

UPON FAILURE OF COUNSEL TO FILE THE CASE MANAGEMENT REPORT OR ATTEND THE CASE MANAGEMENT HEARING, THE COURT MAY DISMISS THE ACTION, STRIKE PLEADINGS, LIMIT PROOF OF WITNESSES OR TAKE ANY OTHER APPROPRIATE ACTION AS PROVIDED IN RULE 1.200(c), Fla. R. Civ. P.

THIS CASE MANAGEMENT HEARING MAY NOT BE CANCELLED WITHOUT THE COURT'S WRITTEN PERMISSION.
